<p>Learning Unit 2.4</p>	<p>COMMUNICATION</p>
<p>Activity Description</p>	<p>Background: If we want to make a good impression in job interviews and we want a successful interview, we need to learn and apply effective communication methods. In this module, there is information about both verbal communication and body language, which are necessary for effective communication.</p> <p>Tasks:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The teacher explains effective communication via the information in the video.</li> </ol> <p>As a follow up activity, the teacher invites the students to sit back to back in pairs.</p> <p>Step 1: One is asked to describe her room, and the other, according to the explanation, to draw without asking questions.</p> <p>Step 2. Students share and check out the drawings, discussing what it feels like to have one-way communication when there is no opportunity to get feedback or ask questions while sharing their experiences.</p> <p>Step 3. With group work “What makes active listening good?”, students are asked to make a list together. Invite students to give spontaneous answers and write them down on a piece of paper. Discuss further why active listening is important when it comes to leadership.</p>
